- Those who have completed a 12-year course in school education in a foreign country or its equivalent, as designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
- 2. Those who have residence status of "Student" as defined by the "Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act".
- 3. Those who have N2 or its equivalent of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test.
- 4. Must have taken one of the following examinations and be able to provide proof of one's scores (for applicants who take the

- 1. Document review
- 2. Written exam Japanese (100 points, 60 minutes)
- 3. Interview (Two interviewers per applicant, 10 minutes)
 - Applicants who do not reach the benchmarks set in the Japanese and English interviews will be rejected.

2. Applicant Qualifications

Must fulfill the following four conditions:

- Those who have completed a 12-year course in school education in a foreign country or its equivalent, as designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
- 2. Those who have residence status of "Student" as defined by the "Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act".
- 3. Those who have taken the EJU (Japanese) in Japan after April 2022.
- 4. Must have taken one of the following examinations and be able to provide proof of one's scores (for applicants who take the exam after April 2022):
