2. Applicant Qualifications

Applicants must meet the following four conditions:

1. Has completed a 12-year course in school education in a foreign country or its equivalent, as designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
2. Has a residence status of “Student” as defined by the “Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act”.
3. Has taken the EJU (Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students) (Japanese) in Japan after April 2023.
4. Has taken one of the following examinations, and is able to provide documentation of their scores (for applicants who take the exam after April 2023)

Exam Name
TOEFL iBT
TOEIC (Listening and Reading)

3. Selection Process

1. Application screening
2. EJU (Japanese) (reading comprehension, listening/ reading comprehension, writing 450 points)
3. Interview (Two interviewers per applicant, 10 minutes)
 - Applicants who fail to meet the benchmarks set in the application screening and interview will be rejected.

- TOEIC-IP results from the Institutional Group Program will not be accepted as an application qualification.
- Only the total score from each EJU and English qualification or proficiency exam will be valid. If applicants take these exams multiple times the highest scores in each subject/ skill section will not be combined.
